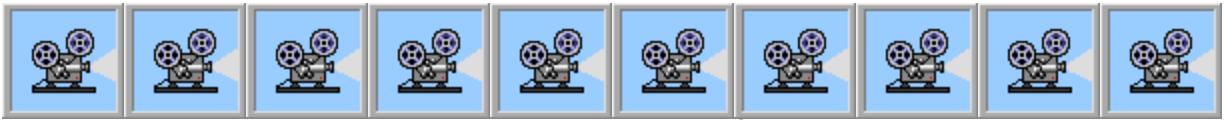


"Grip 101" Workshop

Instructor Dan Allers, a veteran of 32 years in the entertainment field, has provided lighting for more than 500 live stage productions and dozens of television shows. Allers' company, Idaho Cinematic Equipment, will have a three-ton grip truck available for rent in Idaho early next year. "In the interest of building a solid workforce for a growing film industry in Idaho, I am offering a beginning workshop for interested technicians to learn how the proper equipment can make their projects look better," Allers said. "They will also have an opportunity to network with other film professionals and explore creativity, innovation and the power of partnerships." *

Morning session -- 9:00 to 12:00: Equipment and Tools

Afternoon session -- 1:30 to 5:00: Light, Shade and Color

"When out-of-state film producers look at Idaho as a potential location for shooting, they want to know if workers are available who have basic knowledge of the equipment," Idaho Film Bureau Chief Peg Owens said. "This training will move Idaho much closer to being a location attractive to film makers."
